Your 2014-2015 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid office will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

- ❖ **Complete Sections 1-3 and sign the Verification Worksheet. Make sure to carefully read all instructions as errors can delay processing of your financial aid.**
- ❖ **Submit the completed worksheet along with copies of 2014 IRS Tax Return Transcripts (if requested-See section 3) and any other documents to the Financial Aid Office.**

### Section 1 – Family Information

Write the student's name and the names of all family members in the household, age, relationship to student, college, and enrollment status.

If you are **Independent** you will include the following:

- yourself, and your spouse if you have one, and
- an unborn child may be listed if it will be born by June 30, 2016 (give the "due date" instead of age), and;
- other people if they now live with you and you provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half their support from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

**Note:** You are **DEPENDENT** if:

- You were born after January 1, 1992,
- As of today you are not married, at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year
- you will not be working on a master's degree,
- you are not currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces, you do not have children who receive more than half their support from you,
- you do not have dependents other than children who live with you and receive half their support from you.

If you are **Dependent** you will include the following:

- yourself, and your parent(s) (including stepparent) even if you don't live with you parents, and
- your parents' other children, even if they don't live with your parent(s), if (a) your parents will provide more than half of their support for your children, if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, even if they do not live with you, and; on July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, or (b) the children would be required to provide parental information when applying for Federal Student Aid, and other people if they now live with your parents and your parents provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide half their support from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016
