



CEI BRIDGE TO SUCCESS APPLICATION

ATTENTION 2019 High School Graduates:

Bridge to Success at the College of Eastern Idaho is an intensive eight-week summer program that provides first time, degree-seeking students a head start in their transition to CEI. This summer is a pilot available to 15 eligible students. Program students will be able to accomplish greater academic success by developing essential classroom and workplace skills, engaging in community learning, familiarizing and using campus resources, and establishing social and academic relationships with peers, faculty, and staff. A grant from the Idaho STEM Action Center funded the pilot summer, so this year **there is NO COST for the program.**

The Bridge to Success program meets June 3 through July 25, 2019. Students are required to attend the program from 8:30am to 12:15pm, Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Thursday afternoons will offer a lunch and brief activity from 12:15pm to 1pm.

Eligibility requirements: Must be a 2019 high school graduate from within Bonneville County. Seniors outside of Bonneville County and juniors in high school (preparing for a senior year starting fall 2019) may apply, but acceptance is on a space-available basis (15 spaces). Courses taught will be Communications 101 (three credits) and Psychology 101 (three credits, for a total of six credits). Students who have completed these courses previously are not eligible for the program and students must take both courses as a cohort.

The schedule is as follows:

- 8:30-9:45 am: COMM 101: M,T,W,TH
- 10 to 11 am: Study Skills and Activities: M,T,W,TH
- 11 am to 12:15 pm: PSY 101: M,T,W,TH
- 12:15 pm: Students may use any campus resources available or may leave
- 12:15pm to 1pm: Thursdays only: Lunch and Speaker

Information provided determines placement into program and is CONFIDENTIAL. Submitting this application indicates that I understand the requirements and am able to commit to the entire eight-week summer program. Failure to attend the full summer bridge program will result in standard penalties per the CEI Student Handbook and CEI Catalog.
